

Instructions --- Completing The Candidate Fact Sheet:

Please remember: This is your opportunity to demonstrate to the judges why they should consider you for the job of *Miss Apopka*. You may list as many or as few items under each category as you desire except where indicated otherwise. Your only restriction is that it must fit on one page and that you do not use not use a font style smaller than 10” and no larger than 12” point type using the Times New Roman font style.

Name: Please state your name as you would like it listed in the program book.

Title: Please state the full name of your local title.

Date of Birth: Month, day and year of your birth, i.e. October 10, 1980.

Education: List your most recent school first – if it is grad school, indicate it as such. Then list your undergraduate school and your student status, i.e. Freshman, Sophomore, etc, your college Major and Minor, if applicable. Below that, list your high school. And graduation date.

Scholastic Ambition: Type the degree/education sought/achieved. If you have graduated college, list your undergraduate degree and the degree that you are seeking in higher education, if applicable.

Career Ambition: List your career goal(s) – Do not list more than 3.

Platform Issue: Do not type anything but the title, i.e. Celebrating Today’s Youth.

Talent: Type the type of talent and specific selection you will perform (i.e.) Pop Vocal, Classical, Tap Dance, Piano, etc. List the name of the musical selection that will accompany your performance.

Scholarship Honors: List the most recent honors that you have received. A semi-colon should separate each item.

Leadership Roles: a semi-colon should separate each item listed.

Accomplishments: a semi-colon should separate each item listed.

Interesting Facts: a semi-colon should separate each item listed.

Employment: a semi colon should separate each item listed.

What three words best describe you? Use only 3!

“Why I should be Miss Apopka” – Explain to the judging panel why you feel you should be selected as Miss Apopka. This is your opportunity to let them know why you are the right person for the job of Miss Apopka.

This entire form MUST FIT ON ONE PAGE using the Times New Roman font style. You must leave a 1” margin on each side of the page. Use your space wisely. Use your best judgment on what is most important for the judges to know about you. Any variations from this form will not be accepted. Forms must be typed; handwritten forms are not acceptable. If it is proven that any information on these forms is not true, correct and factual, you risk losing your local/state title.
